**Notice of tax question**

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING BE  
ADOPTED?**

“Shall a retailers’ sales tax in the amount of one-half percent (.5%) be levied in the City of Lyndon, Kansas, for the purpose of providing additional revenue for public services within the City, including, but not limited to the maintenance, replacement, improvement and expansion of City water and sewer systems, public streets and culverts, and public parks to take

effect on April 1, 2026 and expire on March 31, 2036.

**School bond question**

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall Unified School District No. 450, Shawnee County, Kansas (Shawnee Heights) (the “District”) be authorized to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$65,000,000 (the “Bonds”) to pay the costs to construct, furnish and equip:  
(a) improvements, additions and renovations to Berryton, Shawnee Heights, Tecumseh North, and Tecumseh South Elementary Schools, including classroom, ADA accessible playgrounds, building, mechanical, HVAC, parking and pick-up/drop-off improvements; (b) improvements, additions and renovations to Shawnee Heights Middle School, including classroom, new gymnasium, building, mechanical, HVAC, parking and transportation improvements; (c) improvements, additions and renovations to Shawnee Heights High School, including classroom, new gymnasium, stadium fieldhouse addition, kitchen, building, mechanical, HVAC, parking and transportation improvements; and (d) all improvements related thereto (the “Project”); and pay costs of issuance and interest on the Bonds during construction of the Project, all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.*, K.S.A. 25-2018(f), K.S.A. 72-5457, and K.S.A. 72-5458 *et seq.*?

- The deadline to apply for an Advance ballot to be mailed is end of day Tuesday, October 28, 2025
- The hours of voting in all precincts of the county will be from 7:00a.m. to 7:00P.M. on election day.
- Voter registration closes at the end of the business day on Tuesday October 14, 2025.

#### **Notice of equipment testing**

Notice is hereby given that there will be a test of election equipment on Friday October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 10:00AM in the county election room, second floor, courthouse, 717 Topeka Ave Lyndon Kansas. All interested are welcome to attend.

#### **Notice of ballot audit**

In compliance with the provisions K.S.A. 25-3009 after an election and prior to the meeting of the county board of canvassers to certify the official election results for any election in which the

canvassers certify results, the county election officer shall conduct a manual audit or tally of each vote cast, regardless of the method of voting, in 1% of all the precincts with a minimum of one precinct located within the county. The precinct or precincts shall be randomly selected, and selections shall take place after the election. The audit will take place November 6<sup>th</sup> @ 4p.m in the Osage County Clerk's office.
